The flavors of Japan on select flights

Air Tahiti Nui rethinks its meals on board its Japanese line Published in La Dépêche de Tahiti on Thursday, February 21st, 2013

The Japanese chef Masakatsu Kumagai was in Fenua to prepare model meals to be served on ATN's Papeete-Narita line. Since 2007, Air Tahiti Nui has been creating a new range of meals every three years for its passengers on board Papeete-Narita, completely changing its colors, flavors and presentation for the mainly Japanese tourists returning to their country. Though the meals on the departure flight are prepared by a Japanese company, on the return flight (Papeete-Narita), it is up to Newrest to provide the meals. There's no way that Air Tahiti Nui can ask the company, based out of the airport, to offer only uru, coconut milk and raw fish. "After one to two weeks spent in Polynesia, Japanese tourists are happy that we can offer them food from their own country when they board the plane", confided Thierry Brandelli, assistant manager of catering for ATN.

The meals are precise. 250 grams for business class, 210 grams for economy class. This year, once again, the TFK Corporation sent one of its Japanese chefs to create 24 meals, 16 of which will be reproduced by Newrest chefs and served on flights.

The Japanese chef isn't a young bud in the restaurant industry. In fact, Masakatsu Kumagai already has 33 years of experience in the kitchen. In 1979, he started his career as an employee in a Japanese restaurant, and the opportunities quickly started rolling in. He joined the Japanese Food Kitchen of the TFK Corporation, whose main focus is catering for Japan Airlines (JAL). He was then transferred to LSG Sky Chefs in Germany, where he looked after customer satisfaction for JAL and Lufthansa. In 1999, he worked in the United States for the Nikko in-flight catering company, where he was in charge of JAL, Delta Airlines and Singapore Airlines. In 2003, he returned to the Japanese Food Kitchen (TFK Corp) in Japan as Executive chef before obtaining his current position as Master executive chef.




Présentation des produits SNCF en gare de Lyon WEDNESDAY, 13 NOVEMBER 2013

In the framework of its expansion in Morocco, Newrest Group has acquired 100% of ATASA, the Moroccan subsidiary of the Spanish Areas Group, present in airport concessions - airport bars and restaurants, mainly in Casablanca, Marrakesh, Tangier, Rabat and Agadir – and collective and inflight catering, mostly serving leading European and Middle Eastern international airlines. Its turnover totals close to €10 million, and it employs 250 individuals.
