### YOUR JOB AND YOUR MISSIONS?

Currently Operation Supervisor at Newrest Chile in the Graduate Program since December 2016, my missions are :

- Make sure the 12 sites in the country (Company, University, Electric station, Mines, ALMA Space Observation station)
- Team management, recruiting and employee management
- Management (finance, accountant) of sites, analyse, reporting, action plans
- Commercial tasks : ensure client service (B to B and B to C), prospecting clients, analyse
